Social Distancing

- Players will not be in dugouts. Outside fences 6 feet apart.
- No spectators on the bleachers. Must spread out along the outfield fence.
- Concession stand will have lines painted 6 feet apart for waiting.
- There are 2 on site bathrooms. Both with only 1 toilet so 1 person at a time. Will be disinfected at the beginning and end of each games sessions.

Face Coverings

- Masks must be worn while on premises by players, coaches, and spectators.
- Players must wear during game play.
- Mask breaks may be taken when proper social distancing can be maintained.

Spectator Guidelines

- Limited to 2 parents and siblings spread out along the outfield.
- Bleachers will not be open.

Communication Plan

- Guidelines will be posted on our Facebook page and our web site.
- A Covid waiver from the Babe Ruth League (they govern our league) site will be signed by all players and parents.

Out-of-State Travel

- As of now teams are not allowed to leave the state to play.
- If any player travels out of state the player needs to maintain quarantine guidelines and produce a negative Covid test.

Attendance and Screening

- Each team will maintain a roster of players and coaches that attend each practice or game.

Hygiene Protocols

- Hand sanitizer will be used upon entering and exiting the field.
- Each team will use their own ball during play.

Sanitation Protocols

- **Facility**
 - We will clean our common areas with general cleaning supplies and will be using an electrostatic disinfectant.
- **Equipment**
 - An electrostatic disinfectant will be available to disinfect equipment.

Cooperation with Health Officials

- We will cooperate 100% with health officials.

Health Screenings

- All players will be asked if they have any Covid symptoms upon arrival at the field.
- Have you recently had a temperature?
- Have you recently had a cough?

Symptomatic Persons

- Any player that has symptoms will be asked to stay home
- If a player is displaying symptoms while at the field they will be sent home and they need to have a Covid test.
- If test is positive the parent must notify the Board of Health and the league will provide the BOH with a roster for contact tracing.

Positive Test of COVID-19

- If we encounter a positive test, we will advise the Board of Health and follow instructions.
- BOH will be provided with a roster for contact tracing.
